The reduced vibration motion with the improved bearings prevent the butterfly assembly from wearing into the box structure. No more needle bearings!"

The McFarlane Tech support guys said "any damaged components, mis-repair and inferior fatigued seals can come loose and block airflow in the carburetor." They also explained that Acorn Welding Air Boxes are approved by a Transport Canada Parts Design Approval and ship with a Form One. This approval is valid as a direct replacement in the U.S. with no STC required.



Replacement components including new flanges, butterfly valves, and seals are available separately for field repairs.
